The Vicar, Electoral Roll Officer and Church Wardens all hold a hard, paper copy of the 'Parish List'. There is also a hard copy in the parish office, as well as on a computer file held securely on the Electoral Roll Officer and on the parish office computer. This document contains the name, address, telephone numbers, email address and roles held within St Peter's of congregation members, volunteers and hall users. It is used for various reasons as outlined in our privacy policy, St Peter's Church, Maney | GDPR (stpetersmaney.org.uk). Each person who holds this document is aware that it is highly confidential and that details should not be passed onto another person without prior, written permission (or in the case of an emergency as outlined in the privacy policy).
